### NCGA Championship Qualifiers

Bayview has designated the following tournament sites as qualifiers for NCGA championships.

For those who wish to compete for these championships, you must be classified as a regular member of our club (juniors under 18 are not eligible) and you must commit to the qualifying and championship dates scheduled by the NCGA. If you can't meet both

conditions, you should not sign-up for the qualifying portion of our designated tournaments.

### Match Play

If there is enough interest from the members for conducting a match play tournament in 1999, one will be setup. However, the competition will not be supervised by or, in any part, be the responsibility of the Tournament Chairman.

The tournament will be organized and run by a volunteer from the club. If any member has a strong desire to fill this position, please contact Joe Zukowski immediately. If no one volunteers, Joe will again serve as the Match Play Committee, rules interpretations and all.

If you are interested in playing or serving as the Committee, contact Joe by Feb 15 (preferably by e-mail so that all can be simultaneously contacted). If we have enough interested players, then entry fees, prizes, schedules and format for the tournament can be established.

### 1999 August Weekend Tournament

This year the club will be returning to Reno and the Peppermill Hotel and Casino. The dates are August 27 through 29. We will be playing the Arrowcreek Golf Club on Saturday and the Red Hawk Golf Club on Sunday. The Friday course has been set for Eagle Creek (West) but the venue is being evaluated and could be changed.

This is a package deal with the hotel that includes lodging for 2 nights, golf with cart on Saturday and Sunday, tee prizes for golfers, reception at the hotel on Friday night and a banquet on Saturday night.

Additional nights will be available for \$69 plus tax. Golf on Friday is not included and will cost an extra \$27.50 per player. We will continue to conduct our usual casino games.



## Local Rules

With the start of a new tournament season, the club wants to refresh old members and introduce new members to 3 local rules for use during our tournament play. These rules were established to help pace of play. These rules are:

### Rule 1 - Lost Ball

If a ball is lost unexpectedly through the green, the player will drop another ball at a point deemed to be near the point where the original ball was lost. This point is determined through agreement with the other players in the group. **The penalty is 2 strokes** (1 stroke for the lost ball and 1 stroke for distance). For example, if a player could not find his/her tee (1st) shot, the ball that is dropped lies 3 making the next shot the 4th stroke.

**Exception:** If the player has reasonable doubt as to where the ball went and that it may not be found, (e.g., on the side of a hill, into the woods, etc.) the player **must** hit a provisional ball from the spot where the last shot was played. This process will continue until the player is confident that a provisional ball is in play.

### Rule 2 - Ball Unexpectedly Out-of-bounds

If a ball goes out-of-bounds (OB), the player will drop another ball, at the edge of the fairway at approximately the point where the original ball lays OB. The drop will be within 1 club length of the edge of the fairway. The drop point is determined through agreement with the other players in the group. **The penalty is 2 strokes** (1 stroke for the ball OB and 1 stroke for distance).

**Exception:** If a player's shot is clearly seen to go OB or if there is a question that it went OB, the next shot **must** be played from the spot where the preceding shot was played. This will be deemed a provisional ball until the status of the original ball is determined. If the next ball is clearly seen to go OB again, a third ball must be played from the original spot. Shots played in this manner are only subject to a 1-stroke penalty.

For definition of a lost or out-of-bounds ball reference USGA Rule 27. Playing of a provisional ball is covered under Rule 27-2.

### Rule 3 - Forced Carry over a Hazard

If the player, from the teeing ground, fails to carry a hazard (e.g., water, ravine, etc.) with his/her first ball, a second ball (i.e., third stroke {1 in, 2 out, hitting 3}) must be played across the hazard. The second ball can either be played from the teeing ground or at the spot where the ball last crossed the margin of the hazard. If played from the teeing ground, the ball may be teed up. If played from the margin of the hazard, the ball will be dropped and played as it lies, unless the committee has declared preferred lies for that tournament. If the second ball fails to cross the hazard, the player will proceed with ball in hand (4 out) to the opposite side of the hazard and drop another ball two club lengths from the margin of the hazard. The player will then add **2 penalty strokes** to his/her score. At this point the player will be lying 6 and hitting 7.

If you have any questions governing these local rules, any club officer will be glad to answer them.



## Upcoming Tournaments



Signups are now being taken for the following tournaments. The fee Bayview establishes for each tournament is determined by contract and includes \$5 for Bayview tournament prizes. The contract covers green fees, cart fees *if required* and merchandise fee *if included*. Please use the enclosed forms when signing up for a tournament and include the total amount for all players submitted. If you are including fees for a guest, select the tees from which they will play, include their handicap number and current index for inclusion into a handicap flight; otherwise, your guest will be placed in a Callaway flight. Guest fees are an additional \$5 over member fees. **Pay attention to the sign-up deadline!**
