Banquet

This year the season ending banquet was held at the Lookout Inn. Attendance was outstanding with 33 members and 21 guests enjoying an evening of socializing and fun. A putting contest for the athletically challenged golfers and non-golfers was conducted over a fiendishly

Los Altos Golf Company

Tournament Fees

The club will continue to include an additional dollar for the PC fund in the tournament fees. The surcharge started in 1995 has resulted in a \$652 balance in the fund. Since this amount will not cover the purchase of a portable PC and the Board of Directors decided using other club moneys to finance the purchase was not justified, the surcharge for 1996 tournaments will be required.

January Tournaments

Flight winners for the tournaments at Rancho Canada and Laguna Seca will receive gift certificates issued from the courses. These certificates will be redeemable only at the course where they are issued. The cost of these tournaments will include a golfer's breakfast and a golf ball. Awards for closest to the pins and fewest putts will be Bayview Bucks or Art Wilson gift certs.

For those looking for weekend lodging, the club has secured a discounted rate at Los Laureles in Carmel Valley. To obtain this special rate a two night stay is required and you must mention the Bayview GC when making reservations. The rate is \$49-\$52.50 per room per night plus a 10% room tax. Match Play

Sign ups for the 1996 match play tournament will start this month and continue through February 20. Play will begin with the March tournaments. The fee will be \$10 with prize payout dependent on the number of players who participate.



Rules of Golf

The following are some but not all the golf definitions included in the USGA's Rules of Golf.

Definitions

Addressing the Ball

A player has "addressed the ball" when he has taken his stance and has also grounded his club, except that in a hazard a player has addressed the ball when he has taken his stance.

Advice

"Advice" is any counsel or suggestion which could influence a player in determining his play, the choice of a club or the method of making a stroke.

Information on the Rules or on matters of public information, such as the position of hazards or the flagstick on the putting green, is not advice.

Ball in play

A ball is "in play" as soon as the player has made a stroke on the teeing ground. It remains in play until holed out, except when it is lost, out of bounds or lifted, or another ball has been substituted under an applicable Rule, whether or not such Rule permits substitution; a ball so substituted becomes the ball in play.

Casual Water

"Casual water" is any temporary accumulation of water on the course which is visible before or after the player takes his stance and is not in a water hazard. Snow and natural ice, other than frost, are either casual water or loose impediments, at the option of the player. Manufactured ice is an obstruction. Dew and frost are not casual water.

Equipment

"Equipment" is anything used, worn or carried by or for the player except any ball he has played at the hole being played and any small object, such as a coin or a tee, when used to mark the position of a ball or the extent of an area in which the ball is to be dropped. Equipment includes a golf cart, whether or not motorized. If such a cart is shared by two or more players, the cart and everything in it are deemed to be the equipment of the player whose ball is involved except that, when the cart is being moved by one of the players sharing it, the cart and everything in it are deemed to be that player's equipment.

Note: A ball played at the hole being played is equipment when it has been lifted and not put back into play.

Ground Under Repair

"Ground under repair" is any portion of the course so marked by order of the Committee or so declared by its authorized representative. It includes material piled for

removal and a hole made by a greenkeeper, even is not ass marked. Stakes and lines defining ground under repair are in such ground. The margin of ground under repair extends vertically downwards, but not upwards.

Note 1: Grass cuttings and other material left on the course which have been abandoned and are not intended to be removed are not ground under repair unless so marked.

Note 2: The Committee may make a Local Rule prohibiting play from ground under repair.

Hazard

A "hazard" is any bunker or water hazard.

Line of Play

The "line of play" is the line which the player wishes his ball to take after a stroke, plus a reasonable distance on either side of the intended direction. The line of play extends vertically upwards from the ground, but does not extend beyond the hole.

Line of Putt

The "line of putt" is the line which the player wishes his ball to take after a stroke on the putting green. Except with respect to Rule 16-1e (Putting Green - Standing astride or on line of putt), the line of putt includes a reasonable distance on either side of the intended line. The line of putt does not extend beyond the hole.

Putting Green

The "putting green" is all ground of the hole being played which is specially prepared for putting or otherwise defined as such by the Committee. A ball is on the putting green when any part of it touches the putting green.

Stance

Taking the "stance" consists in a player placing his feet in position for and preparatory to making a stroke.

Stroke

A "stroke" is the forward movement of the club made with the intention of fairly striking at and moving the ball, but if a player checks his downswing voluntarily before the clubhead reaches the ball he is deemed not to have made a stroke.



Potpouri

From time to time the club receives notices and special offers of interest to golfers. This information is kept in the gray box and will be available to all at our tournaments.

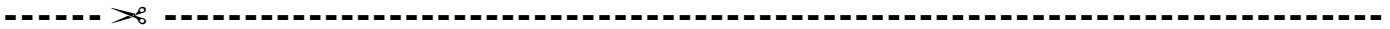

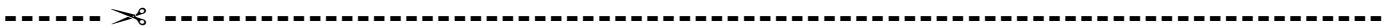
