## Rules of Golf

### Rule 6

### The Player

#### PLAYER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

##### Definition

A "marker" is one who is appointed by the Committee to record a competitor's score in stroke play. He may be a fellow-competitor. He is not a referee.

##### 6-1. Conditions of Competition

The player is responsible for knowing the conditions under which the competition is to be played (Rule 33-1).

##### 6-5. Ball

The responsibility for playing the proper ball rests with the player. Each player should put an identification mark on his ball.

##### 6-6. Scoring in Stroke Play

###### a. RECORDING SCORES

After each hole the marker should check the score with the competitor and record it. On completion of the round the marker shall sign the card and hand it to the competitor. If more than one marker records the scores, each shall sign for the part for which he is responsible.

###### b. SIGNING AND RETURNING CARD

After completion of the round, the competitor should check his score for each hole and settle any doubtful points with the Committee. He shall ensure that the marker has signed the card, countersign the card himself and return it to the Committee as soon as possible.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF RULE 6-6b  
*Disqualification*

###### c. ALTERATION OF CARD

No alteration may be made on a card after the competitor has returned it to the Committee.

###### d. WRONG SCORE FOR HOLE

The competitor is responsible for the correctness of the score recorded for each hole. If he returns a score

for any hole lower than actually taken, *he shall be disqualified*. If he returns a score for any hole higher than actually taken, the score as returned shall stand.

*Note 1:* The Committee is responsible for the addition of scores and application of the handicap recorded on the card - see Rule 33-5.

## Decisions on Rule 6-6a

### Marker Attests Wrong Score Knowingly But Competitor Unaware Score Wrong

**Q.** In stroke play, a competitor returned a wrong score because his score card did not include a penalty he had incurred. The competitor was unaware that he had incurred the penalty. The competitor's marker (a fellow-competitor) was aware of the penalty but nevertheless signed the card. The facts were discovered before the result of the competition was officially announced.

The competitor is, of course, disqualified - Rule 6-6d. Is the marker also subject to disqualification?

**A:** Yes. The Committee should also disqualify the marker under Rule 33-7.

*Editor's Comment:* This decision covers an area of the Rules that could be sensitive to any member of the club when competing in tournaments. That is, calling a fellow-competitor for a Rules infraction. In general, we play the game for fun and want to be congenial with our fellow players because we are basically good people and would like to be thought of as such by others. Calling a fellow-competitor for a possible rules infraction may not come easily to an individual because it may cause some animosity with that player and produce an uncomfortable playing environment. However, we are all expected to play by the same rules and any rules questions should immediately be addressed among those involved. The implication of the above decision is that as a marker for a fellow-competitor that has breached a rule ignored by the marker, the marker is not playing by the Rules and should be disqualified from the competition if the score was knowingly recorded incorrectly.



## Tales from the Caddie Shack

In early 1956 Ken Venturi and fellow amateur Harvie Ward played Ben Hogan and Byron Nelson at Cypress Point in what many people feel might have been the greatest golf match ever played.

Hogan and Nelson were both shy of their forty-fourth birthdays and while neither was at the peak of his game, they both remained formidable foes. Venturi, twenty-five, and Ward, thirty, were arguably the two best amateurs in the country. Venturi had just beaten Ward for the San Francisco city championship and in a few months would finish second in the Masters before turning pro. Ward was the U.S. Amateur champion and would successfully defend his title later that year. He had also won the 1952 British Amateur, was a three-time member of the U.S. Walker Cup team and would finish fourth in the 1957 Masters.

All the players were at Pebble Beach for the Bing Crosby Pro-Am. Early in the week George Coleman, a wealthy Oklahoma businessman, hosted a cocktail party at his home near the lodge where he got into a conversation with Eddie Lowery, a successful San Francisco car dealer who was a patron of both Ward and Venturi. Lowery, who had caddied for Francis Quimet in the 1913 U.S. Open, was so impressed by Venturi and Ward in the city championship that he said he believed they could "beat any two players in the world, pros included." Coleman asked him if he was willing to bet on them and they settled on a bet of \$50,000.

"I'll take Nelson and Hogan," said Coleman, and the match was arranged for the next day. By the time they teed off the bet had been reduced to a more realistic, if less dramatic, \$50.

The match began with very few spectators (a bogus tee time had been made at Pebble Beach to help avoid publicity) but word soon got out and a large crowd gathered. By the end of ten holes, Venturi and Ward were 9 under par, and 1 down.

"It was just an amazing display of golf," Venturi remembered. "It seemed like everyone was topping everyone else. Every hole was being halved with birdies."

"My recollection is we halved every hole from 11 through 15," said Venturi. "I know Ben and I halved 15 with birdies and Harvie and Byron did the same on 16 and 17. They were still 1-up going to 18. I made an uphill twelve footer for a birdie on 18 and Ben had a tough ten footer with a right-to-left break to halve me and win the match. Byron said 'C'mon, Ben, knock it in.' Ben said, 'Don't worry, I'm not going to let us get tied by a couple of amateurs.' He didn't."

Hogan shot a 63, Venturi a 65 while Nelson and Ward each recorded 67. The best ball of the foursome was 16 under par.

"Harvie and I were the best of friends and maybe this was being a little cocky, but we really believed we could take on the world," says Venturi. "You know, now that I think back on it, that's about what we did."
