Handicap Chairman's Corner

Tournament Scores and Equitable Stroke Control

"Equitable Stroke Control (ESC) is the downward adjustment of individual hole scores for handicap purposes in order to make handicaps more representative of a player's potential ability. ESC sets a maximum number that a player can post on any hole depending on the player's COURSE HANDICAP™. ESC is used only when a player's actual or most likely score exceeds his maximum number based on the following table:"

Course Handicap	Maximum Number on Any Hole
9 or less	Double Bogey
10 through 19	7
20 through 29	8
30 through 39	9
40 or more	10

"Peer review is the process of providing a reasonable and regular opportunity for members of a golf club to play golf with each other, and providing access to scoring

records and USGA Handicap Indexes for inspection by fellow members and the club's Handicap Committee."

The above two definitions are from the *USGA Handicap System Manual*.

As Handicap Chairperson I believe the concepts of ESC and Peer Review, "a series of checks and balances", provide the controls required to ensure a player's potential ability is accurately measured. Without Peer Review the correct application of ESC cannot be ascertained.

During the 1998 tournament season I have been monitoring Bayview scorecards for proper application of ESC. The format I used was to give each player a point for annotating an adjusted gross score in the space provided on the scorecards and a second point for correct adjustment. (Note to Bayview Club Members: the handicap chairperson posts ALL Bayview tournament scores with GHIN - only annotate your adjusted score in the space provided on the Bayview scorecards and I'll take care of the rest.) Through the tournament at Cinnabar Hills the club as a whole has performed at 78%. Twenty players have perfect scores thus far with David Fitzgerald and Bob Smearden leading the pack based on having played the most tournaments (and thus having the most opportunity to screw up). Special recognition will be given at this year's annual banquet to the winner.

A performance rating of 78% indicates to me that we as a club need some ESC education. The most common mistakes that I've noticed are; 1) failure to annotate an adjusted score on the scorecard, 2) applying ESC adjustments to net scores rather than gross scores, 3) applying ESC adjustments based on GHIN index rather than course handicap, and 4) other errors such as math mistakes. I encourage each of you to take just a little extra time when calculating ESC. I know we can do better. If there are questions regarding proper application of ESC rules please contact me at one of our tournaments or by e-mail at "matth@aimnet.com". Remember, both the USGA and NCGA take the handicap system seriously and will assess a "penalty score for a player who does not return a score or who otherwise does not observe the spirit of the USGA Handicap System" in accordance with Section 11-8.

I've also had several people approach me regarding away scores they post which have not been showing up on their GHIN cards. If this has happened to you I would be happy to submit the appropriate corrections. Just send me your adjusted score, date played, along with the course rating and slope.



Rules of Golf

Repairing Hole by Player

Procedure:

Rule 20-2. Dropping and Re-dropping

a. BY WHOM AND HOW

A ball to be dropped under the Rules shall be dropped by the player himself. He shall stand erect, hold the ball at shoulder height and at arm's length and drop it. If the ball is dropped by any other person or in any other manner and the error is not corrected as provided by Rule 20-6, the player shall incur a penalty stroke. (*Editor's Note:* No influence can be applied to the ball by the player in the act of dropping.)
